

4th Grade E-Learning Day Plan 2022-2023

Dear Parents & Guardians,

Cold weather is upon us! We need to be prepared for inclement weather and the possibility of no school. The district has decided to implement e-learning days instead of snow days. This allows us not to have to make up snow days at the end of the year. This also means that it is a required day of school attendance. Students must log in on their home device during the e-learning day and complete the assigned work. Attendance is required. Students will not receive credit for attendance if work is not turned in on time and complete. Here is what our e-learning days will look like:

- We will be available via email between the hours of 9am-2pm to answer questions and offer assistance on e-learning assignments.
- Work for the day will be posted by 9am.
- Work will be posted in Google Classroom. Your students know how to access Google Classroom and how to click on the work for the day.
- Each assignment will have instructions and all necessary slides, videos (if applicable), links to work, and assignments attached.
- Students are responsible for completing all aspects of each assignment.
- Students must turn in the completed work on time in google classroom to receive credit for completing the work.
- Students are responsible for completing the e-learning work at home on the e-learning day.
- Once the work is completed on Google Classroom and turned in, the student is finished with the e-learning work for the day.

Pleasant Valley School District #62 families will be notified that we are having an E-Learning day through either a text message or Phone/voicemail. School cancellations will be published on the local area news channels. It can also be found on our PV62 webpage and Facebook page.
