Job Duties & Responsibilities

- Assist in execution of daily lesson plans
- Assist in establishing an appropriate, positive, inclusive and safe learning environment
- Assist in the supervision of students including student arrival, bathroom breaks, lunch, dismissal and in the classroom.
- Other duties as assigned by Bright Futures Teacher and administration.
- As a Bright Futures teacher assistant, you will serve a large part in developing the minds, social, emotional and behavioral skills of young children.
