

E-Learning with Mrs. Buscher

Dear Parents/Guardians,

In case of inclement weather, Pleasant Valley has decided to utilize E-Learning days as an alternative for emergency days. The term “e-learning” refers to a school day when instead of coming into a school building, teachers and students communicate online. These emergency e-Learning days will be utilized if school were to be closed due to inclement weather.

Parents/Guardians will receive an automated phone call or text stating that an “e-learning day” will be used today.

- Students will NOT report to school but should engage in flexible learning activities as assigned.
- I will post work by 9AM for students.
- I will be available through email from 9AM-2PM to answer questions and provide guidance.

Mrs. Buscher’s students will communicate through Google Classroom and email on these days. Assignments can be turned in as a Google Doc or students can turn in their work on paper if they prefer.

Assignments they can expect to see on Google Classroom:

Reading: Students will have Bell Ringers to complete in Google Classroom. Students can expect to find various articles with comprehension questions and written responses through Readworks. They can complete and submit their work through Readworks. Students will also be required to complete a minimum of 30 minutes of silent reading. They can summarize what they have read on a Google Doc or piece of paper. Please make sure you fulfill the minimum time requirement. This may mean that you will need to read several things. Please write a summary for everything that has been read to meet the 30 minute requirement. They will also need to login to Shoelace learning for at least 20 minutes.

Language: Students will be expected to log in to Google Classroom for Daily Grammar. They need to also write 3 complete sentences about what they did that day. Pay attention to capitalization, punctuation and grammar.

Math: Students can expect to find worksheets in their google classroom to complete online. Students will have math muscles in Google Classroom too. Students will also be expected to work on Prodigy for 20 minutes and complete either a quiz or unit test.

Students will be expected to complete their other classwork from their other teachers. The other teachers will have their own expectations shared with you. If you have any questions, you can contact me at mbuscher@pv62.com between 9AM and 2PM.
