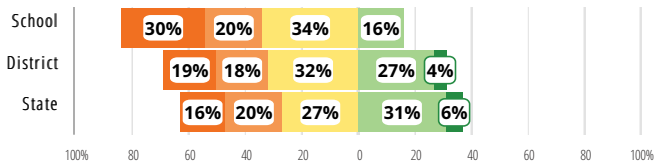

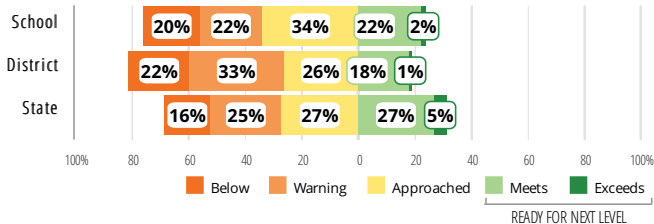
## Academic Success

### English Language Arts



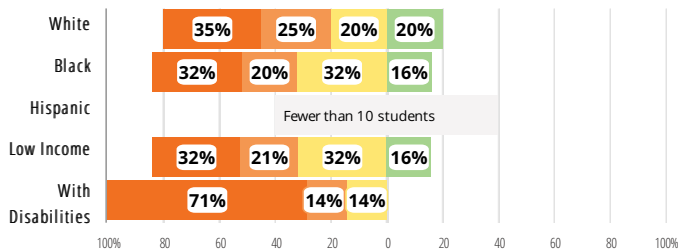

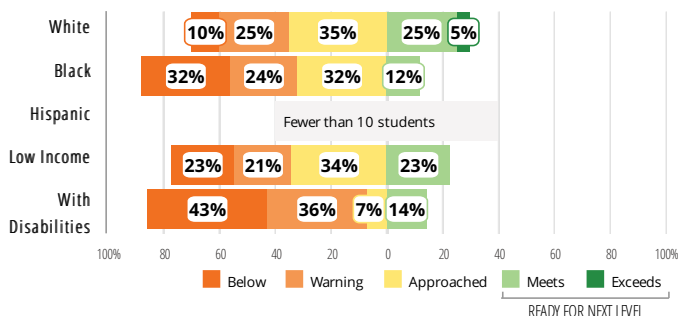
## Success by Student Group

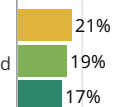
### Attendance Rate

Rate at which students are present at school, not including excused or unexcused absences



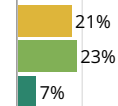
### Chronic Absenteeism

Percentage of students who miss 10% or more of school days per year either with or without a valid excuse



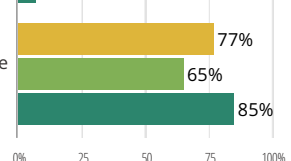
### Student Mobility

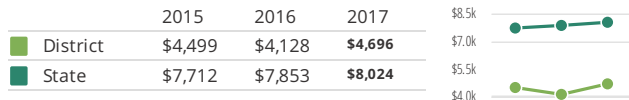

### Facilities

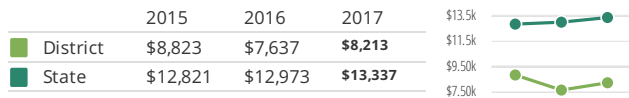
The Elementary School has a secure entrance and video cameras for student safety. All self-contained classrooms are air conditioned.
