Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are at that time of year where weather begins to affect our ability to come to school. If a "Snow Day" is to occur, Pleasant Valley is going to hold E-Learning utilizing our GoogleClassroom account. By holding E-Learning, we will not extend the school year into the summer.

On E-Learning days in order to be considered "Present" to school your child will have to log onto GoogleClassroom. I will post videos and assignments for the students to complete. You and your child may decide the time in which you complete the work but it must get done on that day. Mrs. Knecht, Mrs. Mowder and Mr. Stewart will be available to answer any questions from 9:00-2:00. A GoogleMeets link will be emailed to every student to reach staff members. Assignments will vary, but will be consistent to the list below:

Work to be completed on GoogleClassroom:

- 1. Watch math video and assignment**
- 2. Watch reading video and complete assignment**
- 3. Watch the language arts video and complete the assignment**
- 4. Watch CNN10, by clicking the link attached and write 3 things you heard on CNN10 (in complete sentences).**

****Attendance will only be counted when students interact with the assignments posted on Google Docs. If there is a technological problem or concern, students or parents MUST notify Mrs. Knecht via email or google meets to alert them to the problems they have with logging in or completing the assignments or they will be marked as an unexcused absence.**

***Note:** If your child is supposed to meet with another service provided on a given day, a GoogleMeets link to your student's email from that provider. This includes speech, OT, and social work.

For example: John Doe has social work with Ms. Anderson at 9:30 on Thursdays. Thursday is an E-Learning day, so Ms. Anderson will send an email for your child to receive their service.
