- Diarrhea
- Body Rash

If your student has any of these symptoms please follow the attached chart. If you are unsure of what to do, please keep your child at home and call the school. It is important to note that if **ONE OF YOU CHILDREN HAS ONE OF THESE SYMPTOMS ALL OF YOUR CHILDREN MUST STAY HOME.**
